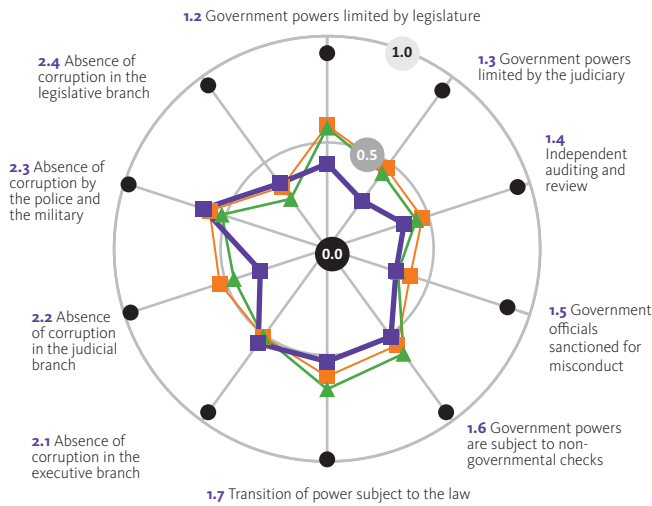

## 2. Scores for all WJP Rule of Law Index sub-factors

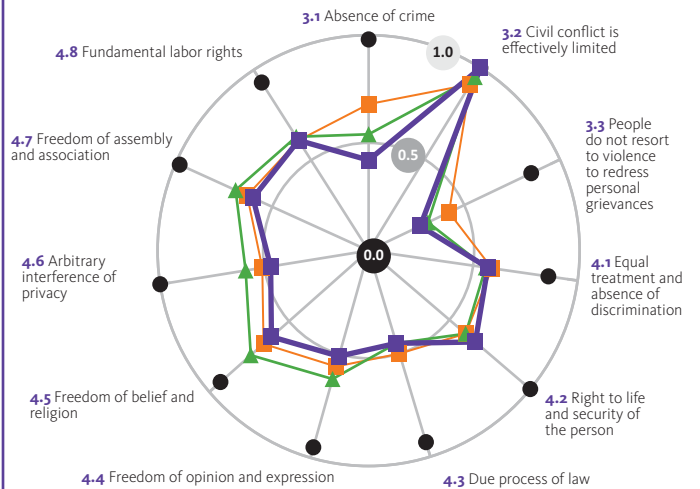

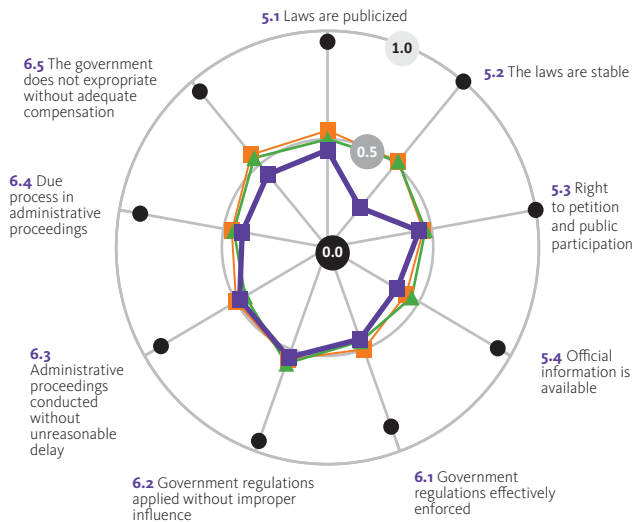
