



“In addition, the difficulties in obtaining a prior appointment have extended to a multitude of procedures that foreign citizens must carry out in police stations throughout the national territory, beyond the scope of international protection. [...] This situation has been aggravated by the measures adopted by the health crisis of COVID-19, because the declaration of the state of alarm meant the impossibility of face-to-face care and the accumulation of workload.”

“[H]e ensured that the condition imposed on asylum seekers to renounce the international protection procedure, if they were granted authorization by rooting, in his opinion, “not only lacks legal support but also implies the breach of the commitment of the Spanish administration to guarantee the right of asylum to those people who are in need of international protection and places at risk those interested who, once they renounce their asylum application, are no longer protected by the principle of non-refoulement.” (Ombudsman).

“In the response issued by the Secretary of State for Migration, it determines, in accordance with the Ombudsman and to guarantee the protection that this group requires, that the fact that a claimant for international protection requests, due to an exceptional circumstance, residence authorization, this in no case may he / she waive the procedure. Likewise, said application for residence authorization due to arraigo in no case may be inadmissible for processing.”
